Topics include a discussion of learning styles, lesson planning, cultural diversity, and the basics of reading instruction. Training sessions are held at LTC, Sheboygan. All training materials and instructional materials are supplied.
- ❖ In addition to the training sessions, all new tutors attend New Tutor Orientation. The brief Orientation session provides new tutors with information on the Literacy Council Project of the Family Resource Center, our One-to-One Adult Tutoring program philosophy, and the responsibilities of tutors and students.
